Industrial Relations

Konor Corporation and its antecedent firms have had no industrial disputes since inception. The business and its owners have always had a close relationship with their staff and have developed a good understanding of the relevant Industry Awards, and their application to satisfy the unique requirements of each Customer's accommodation needs.

SERVICES PROVIDED AS CAMP OPERATORS

Accommodation and Catering facilities can be operated for 20 to 1500 persons and where necessary Konor can supply additional camp buildings, furnishings and equipment to extend an existing camp.

The following services are provided by Konor as standard:

- Meals can be hot freshly prepared or cold buffet style to suit the customer's requirements and scheduled to compliment your working day, shift or rotational roster.
- High quality food properly prepared from high grade ingredients in a hygienic manner with suitable containers for crib preparation.
- All accommodation buildings kept in a clean and tidy condition.
- All crockery, cutlery, pots, pans and utensils needed to perform the day to day preparation and consumption of meals.
- 5. All lawns in the camp area are mowed and trimmed regularly.
- Administration services for personnel booking in and out of accommodation, accommodation register with daily and weekly reports provided to the customer.
- Whilst the facility is not in use, continue to keep all buildings in a clean condition, maintain and water lawns and provide security.
- 8. Community areas, ablution blocks and laundries in the quarters are cleaned daily or more often if required. Individual attention is given to pedestals, basins, windows, mirrors and shower compartments and includes the supply of detergent, antiseptics and cleaning equipment, toilet paper, paper hand towels and holders required to maintain the highest standard of hygiene. Washing machines are wiped down and emptied of any residue remaining at the time of each cleaning. Lint filters in the dryers are cleaned on a daily basis.
- 9. Communal rooms and hallways are cleaned daily (swept and mopped) in the accommodation units. Each week the individual rooms are cleaned, the linen changed and the bed remade. Towels are changed twice per week and persons engaged in dirty work are supplied with additional towels on an exchange basis.

- 10. Sheets, pillow slips and towels are laundered each week and blankets/doonas are maintained in a clean and sanitary condition to the satisfaction of the customer, and laundered at a minimum of quarterly intervals and on each change of occupancy.
- 11. Your facility's environment is maintained in a clean and tidy state with cleaning and rubbish removal services tailored to reduce the impact on your personnel.
 - daily emptying of all rubbish bins provided by Konor in the quarters, around the buildings and daily pick-up of all litter and rubbish lying in the quarters
 - daily removal of garbage from the dry store and the quarters buildings
 - twice daily collection of garbage from the mess garbage area and the cleaning of all bins when empty
- 12. Responsible for the inspection of all fire extinguishers and hose reels and for the reporting of any failed, empty or damaged cylinders or hose reels to the customer.


